

Article IV Section 1A part 1 **PASSED 9/26/04**

Currently reads: Initiates shall be EMU students who have completed a minimum of 12 EMU credit hours.

Amend to: Initiates shall be EMU students who have completed a minimum of one semester of accredited University or College work.

Article IV Section 1A part 3 **PASSED 9/26/04**

Currently reads: Initiates must be able to serve at least three active semesters before applying for Alumni status, not including the initiate semester.

Amend to: Initiates must be able to serve at least two active semesters before applying for Alumni status, not including the initiate semester.

Article V Section 6D **PASSED 9/26/04**

Currently reads: Propose, in conjunction with the Executive Board, the budget for the next fiscal year.

Amend to: Propose, in conjunction with the Executive Board, the budget for the next semester.

Article VII Section 2C **PASSED 9/26/04**

Currently reads: The Alumni Advisor must attend all mandatory events and business meetings.

Amend to: The Alumni Advisor must attend all business meetings and as many Chapter activities as possible.

Article XV Finances add as Section 8 and 9: **PASSED 9/26/04**

All accounts of Alpha Phi Chapter shall require the signatures of two (2) designated signers established by the Executive Board. All checks and/or withdraws from Alpha Phi Chapter Accounts shall require the signatures of at least two (2) designated signers of the account.

Article IV Membership Section 1A Initiates Add as 5 and 6 and re-number accordingly: **PASSED 10/31/04**

At a regular meeting prior to Pinning, prospective members must be nominated by an Active Member to begin the Initiation process.

An Initiate must be nominated to remain in the Initiation Program at the next regular meeting following a point check and/or quiz.

Article IV Membership Section 1B Actives part 1b **PASSED 11/7/04**

Currently reads: Active Members must maintain at least a 3.00 grade point average on a 4.00 scale.

Amend to: Active Members must strive to maintain at least a 3.00 cumulative grade point average on a 4.00 scale.

Article IV Membership Section 1B Actives part 1c **PASSED 10/31/04**

Currently reads: Every Active Member must serve on at least one permanent committee per semester.

Amend to: Every Active Member must serve on at least one permanent committee per semester, with the exception of those members serving as a committee chair.

Article IV Membership Section 1B Actives part 3 **PASSED 10/31/04**

Currently reads: 3. If a Member fails to meet any of the requirements, he/she may be brought up for disciplinary action as defined in Article XIV until such time as he/she meets the requirements of active status.

Amend to: 3. If a Member fails to meet any of the requirements, he/she may be brought up for disciplinary action at any time as defined in Article XIV until such time as he/she meets the requirements of active status.

Article IV, Section 1B, part 1f, Active Members **WITHDRAWN**

Currently reads: Active Members must participate in at least two service projects per semester, one being the initiate service project.

Amend to: Active Members must participate in at least three service projects per semester, one being Adopt-a-Highway and one being the initiate service project.

Article IV, Section 1C Locally Inactive Members to rewrite as: **PASSED 11/7/04**

1. All letters requesting Local Inactivity must be submitted to the Chapter Secretary before the beginning of the second regular meeting of the semester.
2. Letters requesting Local Inactivity must meet the following requirements in order to be presented to the Chapter:
 - a. Any outstanding balance must be paid or a Payment Plan must be submitted with the letter requesting inactivity.
 - b. National and Local dues must be submitted with the letter requesting Local Inactivity.
3. Upon receipt of the letter and Payment Plan (if applicable), Local Inactivity shall be determined by a simple majority vote of the Active Members present at the second regular meeting of the semester.

4. Locally Inactive Members are not required to attend any activities, but are strongly encouraged to attend as many events as possible.
5. For those seeking a second consecutive semester of Local Inactivity, the following applies:
 - a. The Member will present his/her request personally to the Executive Board. The Executive Board will then determine inactivity by a simple majority vote.
 - b. The second semester of inactivity cannot precede the semester he/she plans to petition for Alumni status.
 - c. The Member has the option to appeal to the Chapter if Local Inactivity is denied.
6. Three consecutive semesters of inactivity are not permitted.

Article IV, Section 1D, part 2a, Nationally Inactive Members **PASSED 11/7/04**

Currently reads: The Member is not taking classes that meet at the sheltering institution.

Amend to: The Member is still enrolled at EMU, but ~~their~~ his/her classes do not meet on any EMU campus.

Article IV, Section 1E Alumni Members to rewrite as: **PASSED 11/7/04**

1. The Active Member must submit a letter to the Chapter Secretary stating his/her situation to the Chapter by the second to the last meeting of the semester. If all conditions have been fulfilled, the Chapter shall then grant that Member Alumni status.
2. All Active Members may petition for Alumni status if the following conditions are fulfilled:
 - a. Upon graduation from EMU all Active Members in good standing shall become Alumni Members.
 - b. The Active Member transfers or is no longer enrolled at EMU.
 - c. All outstanding balances must be paid in full, or a Payment Plan must be on file with the Treasurer.
 - d. The Active Member must file ~~Form 60 supplement~~ **Graduation/Transfrt/Separation Form** with the Chapter Secretary.
3. If an Active Member will be officially graduating during the spring or summer semesters, the Member can petition for Alumni status the preceding semester.
4. The following Regulations apply to Alumni Members: **PASSED 11/7/04**
 - a. Alumni Members, as defined in the National Constitution, Article IV, Section 1, can, but are not required to attend all Alpha Phi Chapter activities.
 - b. Alumni Members cannot vote as stated in the National Constitution, Article IV, Section 4.
 - c. Alumni Members cannot have a little brother.

Article IV, Section 1F, Honorary Members to rewrite as: **PASSED 11/7/04**

1. Honorary Members shall be members, who, as stated in the National Constitution, Article IV, Section 1E, have demonstrated the highest qualities exemplified by Phi Sigma Pi through outstanding service to their community, Phi Sigma Pi, or the Alpha Phi Chapter, but are ineligible to become Active Members.
2. Honorary Members are not required to participate in the Initiation Program, but are required to participate in the Induction ceremony.
3. Honorary Members shall be elected into Phi Sigma Pi, Alpha Phi Chapter by a three-fourths secret ballot vote and shall follow the same rules and regulations as an Alumni Member.

Article V, Section 1A Officers **PASSED 11/7/04**

Currently reads: All officers shall be Active Members having fulfilled one complete semester of active brotherhood, not including the initiation period, spring, or summer semesters.

Amend to: All officers shall be Active Members having fulfilled one complete semester of active membership, not including the initiation period, spring, or summer semesters.

Article V, Section 1C Officers **PASSED 11/7/04**

Currently reads: All officers shall be familiar with the National Constitution, Chapter Bylaws, and Officer Training Manual.

Amend to: All officers shall be familiar with the National Constitution, Chapter Bylaws, Officer Training Manual, and Officer Transition Manual.

Article V. Section 1 Officers to Add as D, E, and F **PASSED 11/7/04**

- D. All officers must attend at least one training session each with his/her predecessor and successor.
- E. All officers shall maintain all or any records from his/her predecessors, including, but not limited to, an officer inventory document, training manual and the previous year's Form 110 report for his/her office.
- F. Officer's Form 110 reports shall be submitted to the Executive Board and reported to the Chapter by the last regular meeting of each semester.

Article IV Section 1B part 1 to add as g and re-letter accordingly **PASSED 11/14/04**

Active Members must participate in the Adopt-A-Highway service project at least one time from May 1st through April 30th of the following year.

Article V Section 4A Parliamentarian **PASSED 11/14/04**

Currently reads: Advise the Chapter on its activities to ensure that the National Constitution and the Chapter Bylaws are adhered to at all functions of the Chapter in compliance with *Robert's Rules of Order*, the latest edition;

Amend to: Advise the Chapter on its activities to ensure that the National Constitution, the Chapter Bylaws and the Risk Management Manual are adhered to at all functions of the Chapter in compliance with *Robert's Rules of Order*, the latest edition, when applicable;

Add as I, J, K and re-letter accordingly: **PASSED 11/14/04**

I. Assemble and serve as chairperson of a Risk Management ad-hoc committee when deemed necessary.

J. Ensure the attendance and/or organization of a minimum of two (2) programs per academic year to further educate Chapter Members and Initiates on its Risk Management Policy.

K. Have the most up-to-date Bylaws with him/her at every regular business and Executive Board meeting.

Add as Article IV Section 9: The Member-at-Large Shall: **PASSED 11/14/04**

A. Read and guide discussion on any correspondence he/she receives with either complaints and/or praise from any Member, from an unbiased anonymous position;

B. Determine with the President and/or an Advisor the course of action to be taken when a personal complaint letter is received;

C. Be the impartial representative for the Initiate Class to voice questions, comments, and concerns;

D. Submit a written report each week to the Secretary;

E. Be a voting member of the Executive Board.

To strike Article VI Section 8 in its entirety. **PASSED 11/14/04**

To strike Article IX Section 8 (Announcements) **PASSED 11/21/04**

Article XVII: Amendments **PASSED 11/21/04**

Currently reads: These By-laws may be amended at any regular or special meeting with a two-thirds majority vote of the Active Members present, provided that the amendments have been submitted in writing to the entire Chapter at the preceding regular meeting.

Amend to: These By-laws may be amended at any regular or special meeting with a two-thirds majority vote of the Active Members present, provided that the amendments have been submitted in writing to the entire Chapter.

Article IV Section 1B part 1 **PASSED 12/5/04**

To add as h and re-letter accordingly: Active Members must attend at least three (3) Rush events per semester.

Article V Section 2 President To add as R and S and re-letter accordingly: **PASSED 12/5/04**

Serve on the Risk Management ad-hoc committee when established;

Serve as the Risk Management Advisor of the Chapter;

To strike J and re-letter accordingly (attend committee meetings)

Article V Section 3 Vice President **PASSED 12/5/04**

Part E Currently reads: Appoint all Active Members not holding an Office or Chair position to a standing committee;

Amend to: Appoint all Active Members not holding an ~~Office or~~ Chair position to a standing committee;

Part G Currently reads: Create and maintain a Chapter calendar to be distributed monthly to the Chapter, one week prior to its starting date. It should include all mandatory events, committee meetings, all other events, and any other dates relevant to the Chapter;

Amend to: Create and maintain a Chapter calendar to be distributed ~~monthly~~ to the Chapter, ~~one week prior to its starting date~~. It should include all mandatory events, committee meetings, all other events, and any other dates relevant to the Chapter;

Part I Currently reads: Serve as an Ex-Officio Member of each standing committee excluding the Executive Board and the Initiation Committee;

Amend to: Attend all standing committee meetings, if possible;

To add as K and L and re-letter accordingly:

Appoint all non-elected positions in the Chapter with the approval of the Executive Board;

Appoint a qualified Member whose responsibility shall be to maintain, add to and update the Alpha Phi Chapter website and the Alpha Phi Chapter and Alumni E-group mail lists;

Article V Section 4 Secretary **PASSED 12/5/04**

To strike E and re-letter accordingly

Part L Currently reads: L. Delegate the responsibility of calling all Members' absent from a meeting and all Inactive Members to update them if the Brotherhood Development Chair is absent;

Amend to: L. Delegate the responsibility of **contacting** all Members absent from a meeting ~~and all Inactive Members to update them~~ if the **Awards, Scholarship and** Brotherhood Development Chair is absent;

Article V Section 6 Treasurer **PASSED 12/5/04**

Part D Currently reads: Propose, in conjunction with the Executive Board, the budget for the next semester;
Amend to: **Re-evaluate**, in conjunction with the Executive Board, the budget for the next semester;
To add as L and re-letter accordingly: Serve on the Fundraising Committee;

Article V Section 7 Initiate Advisor **PASSED 12/5/04**

Part B Currently reads: Be responsible for, with the assistance of the Initiation Committee, the planning and implementation of the Initiation Program approved by the Chapter Members at a meeting prior to the first Rush night held by the Chapter;
Amend to: B. Be responsible for, with the assistance of the Initiation Committee, the planning and implementation of the Initiation Program **in compliance with the National Constitution** approved by the Chapter Members at a meeting prior to the first Rush night held by the Chapter;

Part H Currently reads: Hold weekly meetings with the Initiates to instruct, review, and test the Initiates on the local and National history of Phi Sigma Pi, the Fraternity song, and all other content of the Scholar's Province and monitor their progress and answer their concerns;

Amend to: Hold weekly meetings with the Initiates to instruct, review, and test the Initiates on the **Local** and National history of Phi Sigma Pi, the Fraternity songs, and all other content of the Scholar's Province and monitor their progress and answer their concerns;

To strike E and F and re-letter accordingly (Initiation Program design—to be moved to Article XII)

To strike P and Q and re-letter accordingly (Initiate history/quiz creation/approval--to be moved to Chapter Historian)

Article V Section 8 Chapter Historian **PASSED 12/12/04**

Part E Currently reads: Instruct the Members about National and Local history;

Part B Currently reads: Elections shall be completed no later than the second to last meeting of the Winter Semester;

Amend to: Elections shall be completed no later than the **fourth** to last meeting of the Winter Semester;

Part G Currently reads: The term of office shall be one year beginning after the Officer Installation Ceremony at the second to last meeting of the Winter Semester and concluding at the second to last meeting of the following Winter Semester;

Amend to: Each Chapter shall elect and install officers annually with the exception of the Initiate Advisor, which shall be elected on a semester basis.

Part B Currently reads: All Chairs shall be familiar with the National Constitution, Chapter Bylaws, and the Officer Training Manual.

To add as C and D:

All chairs must attend at least one training session each with his/her predecessor and successor.

All chairs shall maintain all or any records from his/her predecessors, including, but not limited to, an chair inventory document, training manual and the previous year's Form 110 for his/her chair position.

Amend to: Be responsible for creating prospective member information sheets *with the approval of the Executive Board and/or Chapter* ~~in conjunction with the Initiate Advisor~~;

Article IV Section 6 Awards, Scholarship and Brotherhood Development

Part I Currently reads: Organize productive activities for the Chapter to participate in to develop fellowship; **PASSED 12/12/04**

Amend to: Organize ~~productive~~ activities for the Chapter to participate in to develop fellowship and scholarship at least once a month during the academic year;

Part L Currently reads: Recognize outstanding members and initiates by rewarding them as Brother of the week and Initiate of the week; **PASSED 12/12/04**

Amend to: Recognize outstanding members and initiates by rewarding them as Brother of the week and Initiate of the week *using his/her discretion*;

~~To strike K (sympathy gift)~~ Part K Currently reads: Organize the purchase and delivery of a sympathy gift when a family member or significant other of an active member passes away; **PASSED 12/12/04**

Amend to: K. Organize the purchase ~~and delivery of~~ a sympathy card ~~gift~~ when a family member or significant other of an active member passes away;

Article IV Section 7 Alumni **PASSED 12/12/04**

Part C Currently reads: Keep Alumni and Honorary Members informed by sending them at least two letters per semester that include updated information about all past and future events;

Amend to: Keep Alumni and Honorary Members informed ~~by sending them at least two letters per semester that include~~ *with* updated information about all past and future events;

Part D Currently reads: Invite Alumni and Honorary Members to Founder's Day and Winter Formal with formal invitations;

Amend to: Invite Alumni, ~~and~~ Honorary Members *and their guests* to Founder's Day and Winter Formal with formal invitations;

Article VII Committees **PASSED 12/12/04**

Section 1 Currently reads: The following permanent committees shall exist from semester to semester, with the membership assigned by the Vice President each semester. All committee members shall assist the Chair in fulfilling all duties and responsibilities of the position.

Amend to: The following permanent committees shall exist from semester to semester, with the membership *appointed* by the Vice President each semester *unless stated otherwise herewith*. All committee members shall assist the Chair in fulfilling all duties and responsibilities of the position.

To strike Section 4 (to be moved to Article XIII) **PASSED 12/12/04**

Article IX Meetings **PASSED 11/28/04**

Section 1 Currently reads: There shall be a regular Chapter meeting every week after the first meeting of each semester except for Induction.

Amend to: There shall be a regular Chapter meeting every week after the first meeting of each semester *unless deemed unnecessary* ~~except for Induction.~~

Section 3 Currently reads: The Fraternity song shall be sung at the beginning of each regular meeting unless deemed unnecessary by the President.

Amend to: **"Brothers Are We"** ~~The Fraternity song~~ shall be sung at the beginning of each regular meeting unless deemed unnecessary by the President.

Section 4 Currently reads: Officer reports shall be given in the order the offices are listed in Article V. Advisor reports shall be given in the order the positions are listed in Article VIII. Committee reports shall follow the Officer reports in the order listed in Article VI. Special committee reports shall follow the reports given by the permanent committees. All Officers and Chairs shall stand and face the general assembly when giving their reports. All Officer and Chair reports must be given to the President at or prior to the Executive Board meeting in order to be placed in the next general meeting's agenda.

Amend to: Officer reports shall be given in the order the offices are listed in Article V. Advisor reports shall *follow Officer reports* in the order listed in Article VIII. Committee reports shall follow the *Advisor* ~~Officer~~ reports in the order listed in Article VI. Special committee reports shall follow the reports given by the permanent committees. All Officers and Chairs shall stand and face the general assembly when giving their reports. All Officer and Chair reports must be given to the President ~~at or~~ prior to the Executive Board meeting in order to be placed in the next general meeting's agenda.

Add as Section 1 and re-number accordingly: A quorum of at least a simple majority of the Active Members in good standing shall be necessary to conduct any Old or New Business;

Article X Executive Board Meetings **PASSED 12/12/04**

Add as Section 1 and re-number accordingly: A quorum of at least a simple majority of the Executive Board Members shall be necessary to conduct an Executive Board meeting.

Article XI Special Voting Procedures **PASSED 12/12/04**

To strike A and re-letter accordingly

Part B Currently reads: The ballots shall be collected by the Parliamentarian after sufficient time has been given to vote. If the vote involves this Member personally, another Officer would be appointed by the President to take his/her place.

Article XII Initiation Program **PASSED 12/12/04**

Section 5 Currently reads: The Initiate history scores are not included in the Initiation point system. However, to be eligible for Induction an Initiate must take at least three quizzes and a cumulative final. Each Initiate must average at least 85% on all the quizzes combined and at least 85% on the final alone to be considered for Active Membership.

Amend to: The Initiate history scores are not included in the Initiation point system. However, to be eligible for Induction an Initiate must take at least three quizzes and the **National Membership Exam** ~~a cumulative final~~. Each Initiate must average at least 85% on all the quizzes combined and at least 85% on the **Exam final** alone to be considered for Active Membership.

Section 7 Currently reads: The Initiate Advisor may only assign one Initiate to a Big Brother;

Amend to: The Initiate Advisor *shall* ~~only~~ assign one Initiate to a Big Brother unless the Chapter deems it otherwise;

Section 8 To add A and re-letter accordingly: Serve as an example and source of guidance for his/her Little Brother.

Add as Section 9 and 10 and re-number accordingly:

The Initiate Advisor in consultation with the Public Relations/Rush Chair shall assign each Initiate an I-Friend.

Each I-Friend shall:

A. Be present at the Pinning Ceremony.

B. Be an Alumni or Active Member who will not be taking a Little Brother the semester he/she is an I-Friend unless the Chapter deems it otherwise.

C. Exchange contact information with the Initiate the night of Pinning.

D. Contact the Initiate at least every other day during the period between the Pinning Ceremony and the Big Brother Ceremony.

E. Serve as an example and source of guidance for his/her I-Friend.

Add as Section 2 and re-number accordingly: The Initiation Program shall have a start and end date by the first Rush event of each semester.

Article XIII Mandatory Events

Section 1 Currently reads: Mandatory events for Active Members include: Pinning, Pinning Party, Founder's Day, Induction, Brotherhood Party, Committee Meetings, a Chapter fundraiser, a Chapter service project, an Initiate service project, all Rush events, and regular business meetings. **PASSED 11/28/04**

Amend to: Mandatory events for Active Members include: Pinning, Pinning Party, Founder's Day, Induction, **Induction Party**, Brotherhood Party, Committee Meetings, **two** Chapter fundraisers, **two** Chapter service projects (**one being Adopt-A-Highway**), an Initiate service project, all Rush events, and regular business meetings.

Add as Section 5 and 6 and re-number accordingly: **PASSED 11/28/04**

Pinning and Induction dates and times must be set before the first Rush event.

When two planned events are in conflict and the conflict is irresolvable, the Chapter will decide which event shall stand.

To strike Section 5 **FAILED 11/28/04**

Article XIV Disciplinary Procedures **PASSED 11/28/04**

Add as Section 1 and re-number accordingly: Any Member who is not currently delinquent in any financial remittance or in the submission of any required forms or reports and who is not currently the subject of any disciplinary action shall be considered a Member in good standing.

Article XV Finances **PASSED 12/5/04**

Add as Section 10: Fines

A. The fines shall be issued by the Secretary and collected by the Treasurer.

B. All Members shall be fined if they are unexcused from the following events:

Currently reads: **Alcohol Policy**

Section 1: In accordance with all governing laws and policies, Federal, State, and University, each person is individually responsible for his/her actions when consuming alcohol. The Chapter shall follow all rules and regulations concerning the consumption of alcohol and Chapter liability as put forth in the National Constitution in Article XX.

Section 2: A majority vote will be taken at a Chapter meeting per semester to determine if the chapter wants a presentation (lecture, forum, or similar activity) to be hosted by and for the Chapter on substance abuse with the current academic year.

Section 3: No alcohol shall be consumed at mandatory Phi Sigma Pi events by any Member, Alumnus, or Initiate. Alcohol consumption prior to or following a mandatory event is at the sole discretion of the host/hostess of the event.

Section 4: If an Active Member, Inactive Member, Alumnus, or Initiate violates this policy, he/she will be brought up for disciplinary action as stated in Article XIV.

Amend to: **Prohibitions**

Section 1: In accordance with all governing laws and policies, Federal, State, and University, each person is individually responsible for his/her actions. The Chapter shall follow all rules and regulations as put forth in the National Constitution in Article XX.

Section 2: Until such time as the Chapter develops and approves its own Risk Management Policy, the Chapter shall abide by the National Risk Management Policy.

Section 3: If an Active Member, Inactive Member, or Initiate violates the Risk Management Policy, he/she will be brought up for disciplinary action as stated in Article XIV.
